Student Organization Council Election Process

The Assumption University Student Organization has a clear process for publicizing, recruiting, verifying qualifications, and electing candidates to ensure a well-qualified and widely accepted AUSO president. The university promotes student participation through the following steps:

- The university appoints an election committee comprising faculty members from the Student Affairs Division, current AUSO committee members, and faculty representatives from various departments.

- The election is publicized, and applications for presidential and vice-presidential candidates are opened.

- Candidates' qualifications are reviewed and interviews conducted by faculty and senior student leaders.

- A confirmation vote is held among representatives of various student activity units, during which candidates present their vision and policies.

- Candidates who pass the confirmation vote are allowed to campaign through the AU Spark application.

- The election committee reviews and certifies the results, and the successful candidates are announced and congratulated.

Confirmation voting for candidates is conducted by representatives from various student activity units.
